

The board convened at 5:30 p.m. Present were Selma Irey, president; Terry Wood, first vice president; Ann Halsey, second vice president; Sheila Johnson, secretary; and Dorothy Olson, treasurer.

Open Session

Eleven members signed in for the open session. Selma welcomed them and called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Minutes of the April 9 board meeting were approved. Esther Shelton was recognized as the Good Neighbor of the Month for April and Pedro and Lupe Escalona,

for May.

Dorothy gave the treasurer's report. She has reviewed all receipts and found them to be in order.

Sheila reported that eight installation permits were approved, one denied and one pending further discussion.

Elizabeth gave the office report. Thirty-five recertification notices have been mailed. There have been 33 defaults, three attorney referrals, 46 exterminations and five move-ins.

Fifteen units are available: 12 one-bedroom units, one two-bedroom unit and two three-bedroom units.

Les gave the maintenance report. Units are being checked for working smoke alarms and furnace filters are being replaced. Work on the unit at 4900 N.E. 37th is 75 percent completed.

Selma opened the floor to member comments. Donna Travis won the door prize drawing of a \$25 gift card.

The open session ended at 7:50 p.m.

Closed Session

The board voted to ratify two telephone polls.

The board reviewed a proposal from Signal 88 Security of Jackson County, Mo. for four nightly patrols.

The board voted to accept the proposal and start the service with Signal 88 immediately. Lonnie Hertzel, franchise owner, will then be asked to attend the June meeting to discuss a stationary officer.

Sherri was asked to include information about the new security company in The Brightoneer.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 p.m.

Procedure for Tagging Members Whose Yards Need Cleaning Up From Dog Waste:


1) <u>Maintenance will tag first</u> and the member will be given 48 hours to clean up the dog waste. If this doesn't happen:


2) <u>A second notice will be given for another 48 hours to</u> have the dog waste cleaned up.
