Maintenance Reminders

Work Order Procedures:

- 1. If you need work completed in your unit, call the office for a work order to be written.
- 2. Do not stop a maintenance man to report the problem, call the office.
- 3. Do not call one of the maintenance men on their cell phone to report the problem, call the office.
- 4. Do not add additional items to the job when the maintenance man is in your unit, his time is allotted for the work on the ticket. If additional work is needed call the office for another work order to be written.
- 5. Only emergencies will be handled on calls placed after 4:30 pm. See Tab 3 Maintenance (page 17) of your Rules We Live By for additional information.

Winter Reminders:

Outside faucets should be turned off at the first frost. If you need help please call the office for a work order.

The proper procedure is as follows (Section 5.9 Outside Faucets): Shut water off underneath your kitchen sink (or some are located in the utility room), then open the outside faucet valve and disconnect the water hose. Keep the faucet drain open to allow it to drain completely. If this is not done, it can freeze and burst the pipe inside the wall and member will be responsible for the repair.
