Missouri's annual sales tax holiday



August 5-7, 2016: “Back to School Sales Tax Holiday” – Noncommercial purchases of **clothing** (but not accessories) with taxable value of \$100 or less per item are tax exempt. **School supplies** up to \$50 per purchase are tax exempt. **Computer software** with taxable value of \$350 or less, and **personal computers** and **computer peripherals** up to \$3,500 are tax exempt. Graphing calculators with a taxable value of \$150 or less are tax exempt.

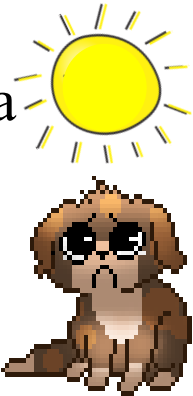

If you notice leaves, cotton or other debris stuck to the fins of your outside A/C unit—Just use your hose to rinse them off. These fins need to be clear so air can circulate efficiently. Rinse with the gentle setting, no need to use a forceful setting when rinsing the fins.

The board convened at 5:30 p.m.

Open Session

Ten members signed in for the open session. Selma welcomed them and called the session to order at 7 p.m.

Minutes of May 10 and June 8 were approved with an address correction.

Esther reported that five installation/alteration permits were submitted and all were approved.

Elizabeth presented the office report.

There have been seven move-ins. One one-bedroom unit is available.

Les gave the maintenance report.

Maintenance is working on rehabs and cleaning air conditioner condenser coils. Last month, two air conditioner condenser units and an A coil were replaced.

Betsy reported for Linville Management Services, Inc.

One application was approved in May and one in June. Five final statements were completed in May and eight in June.

Processed for May in accounts payable were \$192,347.61 and for June, \$192,960.18.

Financial reports for May were mailed out on June 6 and for June, on July 7.

North Brighton's Website is in the final approval stages and will be operational by August of 2016.

Good Neighbors of the Month were awarded: Philip Collier for June and Sharon Cross for July.

Dorothy gave the treasurer's report. She has examined receipts for May and for June and found all to be in order.

Selma opened the floor to member comments.

Donna Chapman won the door prize drawing.

The open session ended at 7:35 p.m.

Closed Session

Les discussed costs of mulch for the playgrounds. The board approved increasing the budget for playground mulch by \$2,000: from \$5,000 to \$7,000.

Dudley reviewed the attorney status report.

Betsy reported that the property insurance is increasing for umbrella increase, fidelity bond, building replacement and business income (for loss). The increase to finish the current policy is \$638. The policy renews on September 1 and will be shopped.

The closed session ended at 8:30 p.m. Elizabeth, Sherri, Les and Chris were allowed to leave.

The board met in executive session. The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.

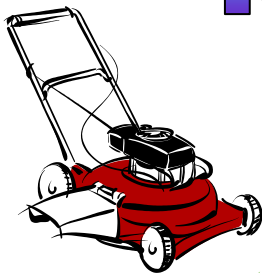
