As preventative maintenance the board voted to have SOS Pest Control perform BedBug inspections in every unit throughout the year. 96 units will be inspected on the 3rd Thursday of the month. With this schedule each unit will be inspected 2 times per year.

Notices will be posted 1 week before & 1 day before the inspection. You are not allowed to skip this inspection.

One of our maintenance men will accompany the inspector into each unit. The inspection will be conducted in each room containing bedding or cushioned furniture.

If you do not receive a notice your unit is not being inspected that month.

## Maintenance Reminders

### **Snow Removal Section 1.9 Vehicles**

J. Members, any person of the member's household, a guest or any person under the member's control are required to park so that their vehicles do not extend over the sidewalks. Should a vehicle extend over the sidewalk during snow removal, the member will be charged. Vehicles parked in No Parking zones that impede snow removal will be towed at the owner's expense without warning. (Also, please remove all items from the porch and stoop for easier snow removal. Maintenance is not responsible for any items left out and damaged during snow removal)


