**Board members present:** Selma Irey, president; Ann Halsey, first vice president; Mike Crippen, second vice president; Dorothy Olson, treasurer; and Esther Shelton, secretary

**Staff present:** Elizabeth Tharp, office manager, and Les Dudrey, maintenance superintendent

**Also attending:** Melva Linville, property manager, and Betsy Kilker, administrative assistant, with Linville Management Services, Inc.

The board convened at 5:30 p.m.

The board approved the minutes of the February 13 board meeting.

Dorothy gave the treasurer's report for March. She has reviewed receipts and all are in order.

Esther reported that four installation/alteration permits were submitted and approved.

Elizabeth presented the office report. There were two move-ins and 48 exterminations in the last 30 days. Two memberships are for sale: a one-bedroom unit and a three-bedroom unit.

Les presented the maintenance report.

Maintenance is working on two rehabs now.

Gutters have been cleaned and downspouts repaired.

Mouseproofing is about 60 percent done. Areas on the front of units where air and mice can get in are being insulated and sealed.

Betsy presented the Linville Management Services, Inc., report for April.

Two applications were approved, five final statements were completed and two letters were sent.

Processed in accounts payable for the month of March was \$189,192.03. Financial reports were mailed to the board on April 6. Newsletter Minutes Continued:

Betsy distributed a completed audit by Darel D. Kyle to the board members.

The annual insurance is due for renewal. The premium with a \$5,000 deductible increases by \$1,646.17 a month. The annual premium is \$208,305.

Increasing the deductible to \$10,000 results in a monthly savings of \$1,943.42 and an annual cost of \$165,230.

The board voted to increase the deductible to \$10,000.

Elizabeth and Les were allowed to leave at 6:45 p.m.

#### New Board Member Orientation

New handbooks were distributed to board members.

Melva reviewed the eight sections in the books and fielded questions from board members.

Board members signed a code of ethics and a confidentiality clause from Tab 2 in the handbook.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
