

The board convened at 5:30 p.m.

Open Session

Eight members signed in for the open session. Selma welcomed them and called the session to order at 7:05 p.m.

Minutes of the May 14, 2019, board meeting were approved with the phone poll ratification.

Trey gave the treasurer's report for May. He has reviewed all receipts and found all to be in order.

Esther reported that seven installation/alteration permits had been submitted and all had been approved.

Elizabeth presented the office report.

There have been two move-ins and 55 exterminations. There are one one-bedroom unit, three two-bedroom units and three three-bedroom units on the market.

Les gave the maintenance report.

Currently seven rehabs are underway.

Five units were treated for bed bugs last month at a total cost of \$6,500. Excessive rainfall caused two roof leaks and three to four back stairwell floods because the drains were covered with debris.

Betsy reported for Tailor Made Property Services. Six applications were approved and four are pending. Processed during the month of May was \$213,247.13 in accounts payable. Financial reports for May were delivered to the board on June 10.

Pauletta Clubine was recognized as the Good Neighbor of the Month for June.

Selma opened the floor to member comments.

Betty Maltbia won the door prize drawing.

The open session ended at 7:20 p.m. and the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.



GRUB EX/GRUB KILLER





Section 1.9 Vehicles, Letter H.—All members and guest shall Recognize and comply with universally accepted rules of the road And the ten (10) MPH speed limit while on property.

This is your annual reminder that it is illegal to use, possess, or sell fireworks in Kansas City, Mo.

Here is what the ordinance says:

Sec. 26-5608.16. Prohibition of Fireworks.

Sec. 26-5608.16.1. Sale, use and possessing; Definition.

- (A) Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to possess, keep, store, offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail, use or explode any fireworks in the city.
- (B) For the purposes of this section, the term fireworks shall mean and include any combustible or explosive composition, or any substances or combination of substances, or article prepared for the purposes of producing a visible or an audible effect by combustion or explosion, in which explosives are used, firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, roman candles, sparklers or other fireworks of like construction, and any fireworks containing explosive or flammable compound, or any tablets or other devices regulated by the US Department of Transportation as a regulated firework.
