NEWSLETTER MINUTES

Board members present: Selma Irey, president; Dorothy Olson, first vice president; and Willia Bailey, second vice president

Board members absent: Mike Crippen, treasurer, and Esther Shelton, secretary Staff present: Elizabeth Tharp, office manager; Les Dudrey, maintenance superintendent; and Chris Curlett, assistant maintenance superintendent

Also attending: Brad Constance, cooperative attorney; and from Tailor Made Property Services: Mike Lauer and Betsy Kilker, regional managers, and Melva Linville, consultant

The board convened at 5:30 p.m.

Minutes of the October 8 board meeting were approved.

Elizabeth presented the office report.

There have been two move-ins. Two three-bedroom units and one two-bedroom unit are available.

There have been four final recertification notices and 54 exterminations. Playground rules signs are being reviewed by members for accuracy of translation into Spanish, Arabic and Somali.

She discussed her trip to Chicago to see software in use at Noble Square Cooperative. The Chicago cooperative uses Rent Manager and Elizabeth compared it to OneSite, currently being used by North Brighton.

Les gave the maintenance report.

Three rehabs are underway. Two units will require \$6,000 to \$7,000 each to bring them up to North Brighton standards.

The maintenance crew changed furnace filters and checked smoke alarms; sealed and painted the monument signs; painted the clubroom; and painted and repaired 484 handrails. Some 300 handrails remain.

Betsy reported for Tailor Made Property Services.

Two final statements were completed.

Processed during the month of October was \$162,343.07 in accounts payable.

Financial reports for October were delivered at the board meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 7 p.m.
