

Maintenance Reminders

- ★ Please do not use rock salt on your sidewalks and stoops, it damages the concrete, Instead use Ice Melt.
- * As it gets cooler, outside faucet should be turned off at first frost.

<u>Procedure:</u> Shut off water underneath your kitchen sink (some are located in utility closet). Disconnect the water hose, open the faucet valve outside. Allow faucet to drain then leave the faucet on. <u>If this is not done, it can freeze and burst the pipe inside the wall. The member will be responsible for repair!</u>

* If you need assistance with the water shut off procedure, please call the office for a work order and maintenance will come out.

Snow Removal

Section 1.9 Vehicles

J. Members, any person of the member's household, a guest or any person under the member's control are required to park so that their vehicles <u>do not</u> extend over the sidewalks. Should a vehicle extend over the sidewalk during snow removal, the member will be charged.

Vehicles parked in No Parking zones that impede snow removal will be towed at the owner's expense without warning.

(Also, please remove all items from the porch and stoop for easier snow removal. Maintenance is not responsible for any items left out and damaged during snow removal)
