# TAX FREE WEEKEND August 5, 6 & 7 - 2022

By state law, the Sales Tax Holiday begins at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, August 5, through Sunday, August 7.

#### The sales tax exemption is limited to:

- •Clothing any article having a taxable value of \$100 or less
- •School supplies not to exceed \$50 per purchase
- •Computer software taxable value of \$350 or less
- •Personal computers not to exceed \$1,500
- •Computer peripheral devices not to exceed \$1,500

Willia opened the floor to member comments and the open session ended at 7:20 p.m. The board met in closed session and the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.


